## Welcome to “Market in the Park”

South Park, Shelters #1 & #2 and area west (W South Park Ave & Georgia St)

Wednesdays

July 19 through September 27, 2017

3:00pm – 7:00pm

Live music each week

Market in the Park will be an agriculture, prepared food, handmade craft and community outreach market.

Full season is encouraged; however, some weekly spaces may be available. Payment will be required at time of application.

All checks will be held until space allocations are made after the **April 29, 2017** deadline for **returning vendors**. **This deadline is for returning vendors to “claim their space” from 2016. Returning vendors forfeit their 2016 space if application is received after the deadline.** All vendors will be notified in writing by **May 12, 2017**. At that time assigned vendors will be given space assignments and checks will be deposited.

**Prior to participation in the Market, all vendors (including community outreach) shall present to the Oshkosh Saturday Farmers Market a valid COI (certificate of insurance) including no less than \$300,000 of liability coverage OR proof that they have included a liability incidental business insurance endorsement on either their farm or homeowners insurance policy including no less than \$300,000 of liability coverage. Coverage shall be maintained without interruption for the duration of the vendors’ participation in the market.**

**This must be received with the vendor application. Scheduling/confirmation of dates will not be done without it.**

Vendors will enter South Park from Georgia St. The entrance (and exit) is one-way.

Vendors may begin to arrive no sooner than 1:30pm and must be set up by 2:30pm.

Vendor’s tents and vehicles will be located near or around Shelters #1 & #2. Spaces are approx. 11’ x 30’ which includes vehicle parking. Vendors will be allowed one space only. ***12x12 canopies are not allowed.***

**If you are a vendor using power, you MUST adhere to what power is available to you by using a 15amp surge protector/power strip and/or use a QUIET RUNNING generator.**
